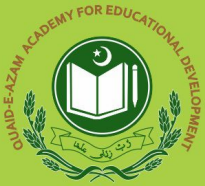

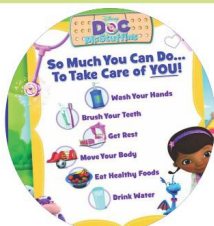
Introduction to ECE Project

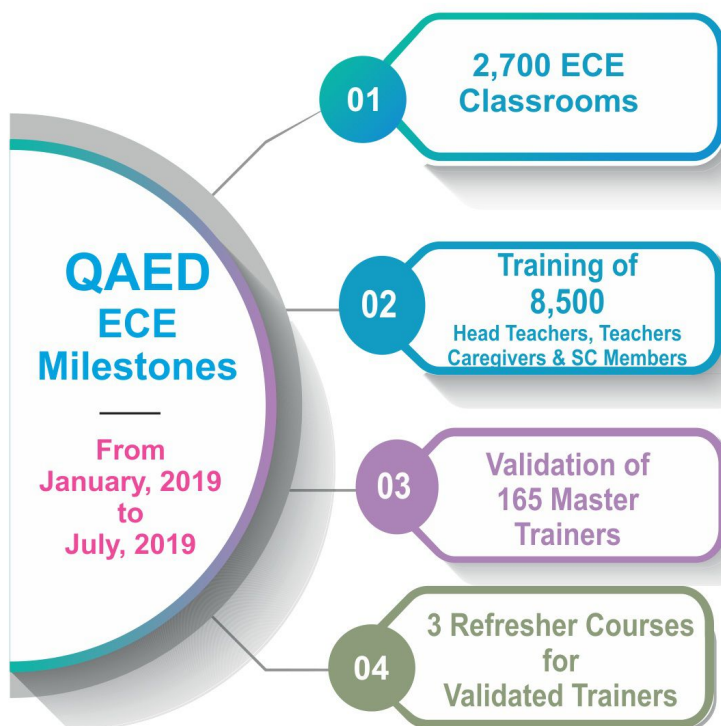

Validation Process of Early Childhood Education Master Trainers

If ECE teachers are well trained, they lay strong foundations of learning in classroom. Keeping in view the sensitivity, QAED Quality Assurance Wing, in collaboration with UNICEF, has devised a validation process for the selection of ECE Master Trainers. Expert ECE educationists from public and private sectors are invited to evaluate and validate training skills of Master Trainers.

ECE Training of Teachers, Head Teachers, Caregivers and School Council Members



QAED, in partnership with UNICEF, regularly imparts training to teachers, head teachers, caregivers and School Council members and establishes ECE classrooms in different districts of the Punjab.

These trainings are aimed at enhancing capacity of ECE teachers and other stakeholders to understand the latest concepts and techniques involved to enrich classroom atmosphere for strong future learning of children.

Refresher Courses for ECE Master Trainers

QAED and UNICEF arrange Refresher Courses on Early Childhood Education for its Master Trainers from all districts of Punjab. These refresher courses are designed to improve training skills of trainers. Certified ECE specialists from private and public sectors are invited to strengthen skills and knowledge of these trainers.

SCHOOL LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME (SLDP)

QAED launched the SLDP, in collaboration with British Council, to develop essential leadership skills (communication skills, presentation skills, motivation, social cohesion, behavior change etc.) that every leader must learn and apply to lead schools effectively. The first phase of this programme aims to inculcate leadership skills in the head teachers of elementary, secondary and higher secondary schools. It enables our head teachers to manage human, financial and material resources effectively in their schools.

Impact of Project

Through SLDP, QAED has trained 15,000 school leaders in 2019. More than 80% of the participants reported that they acquired enhanced skills as a result of participation in training, leading to new leadership approaches and a more inclusive participatory style of school management.

QAED and British Council jointly pursue this by equipping teachers with the skills and knowledge they require to adopt a child-centered, activity-based approach with effective use of languages (Urdu/mother tongue and English). It helps to ensure that students' cognitive and linguistic abilities are developed hand-in-hand, leading to improved SLOs. QAED & British Council provide training, resources and self-directed learning opportunities not only for teachers and trainers but also for district officials and head teachers. This inclusive approach helps to encourage and embed good classroom practice.

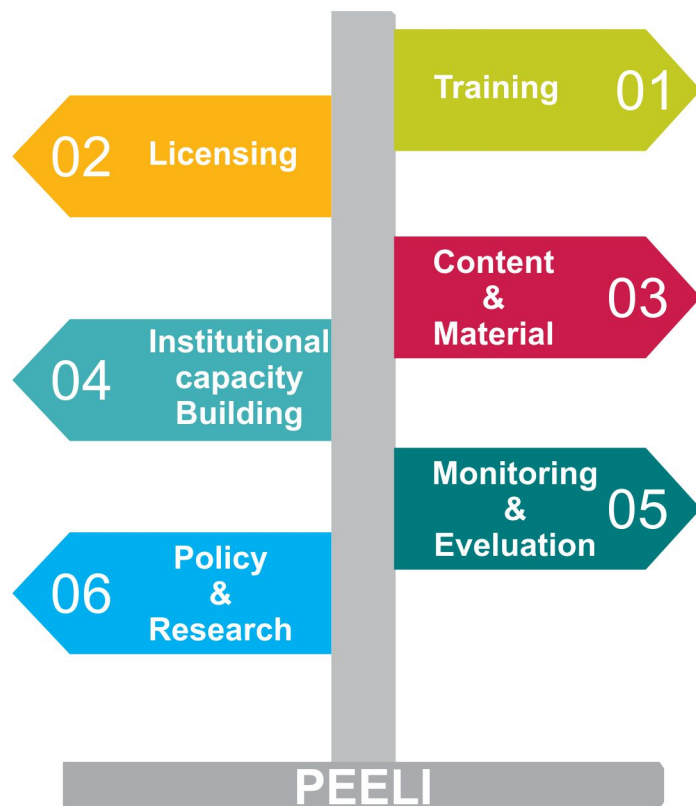

Reach and Impact

By December 2019 we aim to have helped an estimated 200,000 primary school teachers reach their potential and develop the knowledge and skills required to deliver world class teaching in Punjab impacting on the quality of learning experience of an estimated six million children.

Delivery Model: QAED is committed to develop teachers' skills by providing training to 1001 expert trainers who in turn provide training to the primary school teachers.

Methodology: Teaching for Success - driven by the British Council's CPD framework for Teachers and the CPD framework for Teacher Educators (Expert Trainers).

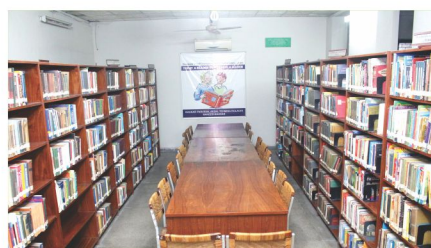

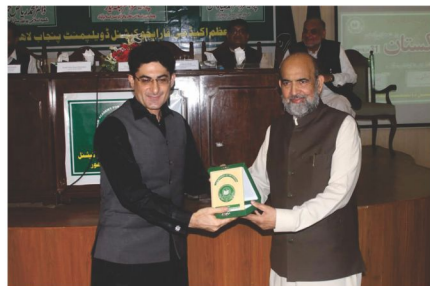
